Continued Receipt of Scholarship Funds From Taylor-Odom Foundation

Funds for the scholarship will be made directly to the recipient.

A scholarship recipient will be entitled to the continued receipt of scholarship funds so long as the recipient complies with all of the following requirements:

- Attend a fully accredited college, university. technical school or apprenticeship program in the State of Texas.
- Enroll and complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours each fall and spring semester or the generally accepted requirements for apprenticeships or technical schools. The award will be divided equally over semesters or grading periods, depending on degree plan at the time of the award. The deadline for the recipient to request money for the fall semester is September 1 and for the spring semester is February 1. If the money is not requested within these guidelines, it will be forfeited.
- Complete fall and spring semesters each academic year unless otherwise approved in writing and accepted in advance by the Taylor-Odom Foundation. Consideration will be given to family emergencies, medical conditions, and other unforeseen circumstances.
- Maintain a cumulative grade point average of not less than 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Provide the Taylor-Odom Foundation with an official transcript and proof of enrollment before scholarship funds will be advanced for the next semester.
- If a student completes their studies or graduates before the total award has been paid, the remaining funds will be forfeited.

It is the obligation of the scholarship recipient to comply with these rules. Failure to comply may result in loss of scholarship funding.
